The fees charged by all Birmingham Outdoor Centres for a week residential is £180 per pupil. In addition to this the cost of coach travel to and from the venue is approx £600.

As a school we believe that the value that children get from taking part in the residential is huge and supports their social and emotional development as well as supplementing the formal school curriculum. With this in mind the school will subsidise the trip for each pupil attending and the cost to you will be £80 for the week. Pupil Premium Fund and the money allocated by the Governing Body for Visits and Visitors will be used as a subsidy.

In order to assist parents with payment we will be offering a savings club so that parents can make weekly payments over the coming months rather than pay the whole amount up front. In the past this has helped many parents to afford the cost of the trip. Each child who is accepted will be issued with a payment card. All payments are to be made to the office (please do not send them to the classroom).

We will be able to take 50 pupils on the trip and as in previous years we anticipate more pupils wishing to go than there are places. The fairest way to allocate places will be reply slips drawn out of a hat, and a waiting list drawn out in order. Please do not enter your child into the draw if they are not prepared to be disappointed. All decisions are final.

Once your child's place has been confirmed, we will send you a confirmation letter which will also ask for a non-refundable £30 deposit to secure your child's place.

If you wish your child to be considered for the trip and you can guarantee the full payment, please return the reply slip by the morning of Wednesday 10th July.
