It is not a non uniform day.

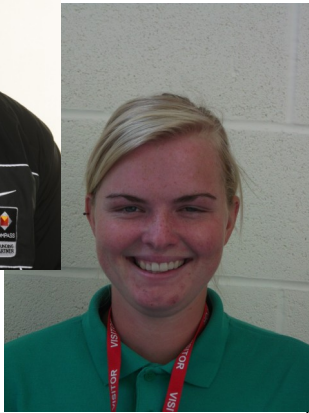

Sports Plus Scheme have been working in schools for over 10 years delivering sports coaching and PE curriculum cover. At Blakesley we offer Curriculum PE support, morning clubs and after school clubs. Coaches are trained in over 50 sports and activities.

Since September in PE we have introduced pupils to basketball, hockey, tag rugby, street dance, mini golf, tennis, skipping and football. Additionally through our clubs pupils have taken part in netball, kombat fitness, gymnastics, and athletics.

Morning clubs run from 7.50am—8.50am and after school from 3.15—16.30pm free of charge, new spaces and activities will be available in the new Summer term, 80% of KS2 have taken part.

The Sports Plus coaches at Blakesley are Mr Summers and Miss Ward. Mr Summers is in school full time and teaches classes throughout the school from year 1—6 and Miss Ward teaches on Mondays with Years 1, 4 and 5.

We hope that the children at Blakesley are enjoying PE this year as we have enjoyed teaching them.
