365 **=** 190 Days in each year School Days

90% Attendance per year for 11 years of schooling is equal to <u>MORE</u> <u>THAN ONE YEAR OF MISSED LEARNING!</u>

Throughout the morning I track and monitor attendance, in the afternoons I work closely with children and their families. The "Attendance Board" will be updated every Friday showing each class' data for the week.
