

RUN - to a place of safety. This is a better option than to surrender or negotiate. If there's nowhere to go, then...

HIDE - Remember to turn your phone to silent and turn off vibrate.
Barricade yourself in if you can.

TELL - the police by calling 999 when it is safe to do so.

We have many ways of making sure children know how to be safe. For example our regular fire drills mean that we know we can evacuate the school to a place of safety in under 3 minutes. We will continue to teach and practice safety procedures. Please if you have concern speak to a member of the Senior Leadership Team.
