"Hi, I'm Charlie Cane the new Speech and Language Therapist. I am employed by a cluster of seven schools and have two days a week at Blakesley Hall. I will be doing a variety of different things whilst in school including one-to-one therapy with children, assessments and classroom observations. I will be working with children who have difficulties with speech sounds, their understanding or producing language. I am in Blakesley Hall on Mondays and Fridays. If you have any concerns about your child's speech, the best way to contact me is to ask for me at the school office or you can request a referral form and I will contact you if you leave your details."

My name is Ishia Yasin. My role as a **Learning Mentor** involves addressing the needs of learners who require the assistance in overcoming barriers to learning in order for them to achieve their full potential. I work with individuals either on a one to one basis, in small group and advice parents/carers on the services available to them. Like many of our children I am mulitilingual and can speak Urdu, Punjabi and Mirpuri. I am based in the Learning Mentors room from 8.30 to 4pm and you can contact me via the main school office."





"My name is Nikki Bailey and I am the full time Attendance Officer. I am a Learning and here to work with all children and families. I am really impressed with the positive attitude from everyone and what a friendly school community you are. Blakesley Hall is a fantastic school and it is my job and aim to work alongside you parents/carers, children and teachers to ensure that high attendance is maintained and lateness is reduced. My role is to support you and your child ensuring that all children come to school on time every day, attend school all the time, feel safe, have fun and learn. 
We have been successful in receiving our Primary Science quality mark-silver award.
