A NOTE TO PARENTS

If a child is racist towards another child or adult at our school this is what happens.

- i. a full investigation is completed by a senior member of staff including witness statement, on a form which is kept in a folder in the Headteachers room.
- ii. Statutory guidance is followed and all incidents are reported to the Governing Body and to the Local Authority data collection team.
- iii. The parents of the victim & the 'aggressor' are informed about the sanction that has been applied.
- iv. The incident is followed up at a later date to ensure racial behaviour has not continued.
