Welcome to Bug Club!

Bug Club is an on-line reading scheme, which allows all children to read books at exactly the right level for them.

If you have access to an internet connection, your child can enjoy reading Bug Club books online at home (including on iPads, iPad Minis and some Samsung Galaxy and Nexus phones).

As well as books, there are also fun quiz questions about each book and your child can earn 'Active Learn Coins'. By reading more books, your child will earn a reward to use in their Bug Club World. Your child will have bought home a letter recently with their log-in details. Please see your child's teacher if you need another copy.
