

Well done to 6S, 5C, 5M and 3K who are already at or above the national target for attendance, Keep it up! A huge congratulations to the 211 pupils who have excellent attendance, they have been here every single day!

Did you know, only 68% children have attendance of 95% or more. Unfortunately, persistent absence (attendance of 90% or less) is still having a huge impact on our whole school attendance. As a result, we have started the process of fining families when pupils are persistently absent. This term one of our families has been taken to court and will receive a Penalty Notice and have to pay a fine. Please be aware that should you choose to allow your child's attendance to fall below 90% each parent could receive a fine.

Good attendance means...

Being in school at least 95% of the time or 180 to 190 days



Next term will see the introduction of lots of fantastic incentives to promote good attendance. New attendance officers will be chosen for each class based on good attendance for this year so far, will it be you? There will also be an End of term Attendance prize for most **improved** attendance. The winners of this prize will get the opportunity to take part in an exciting event with our Head of School, Mr. Protherough.
