Why do children have homework?

- Studies suggest that generally, children who spend more time on homework tend to show higher levels of academic achievement.
- Homework enables children to reinforce, practice and apply the skills learnt in school.
- It allows parents to engage, encourage and participate in their children's learning.
- Homework allows children to demonstrate their abilities and improve their sense of responsibility and time management.
